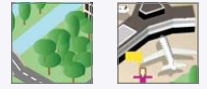

- 1606 Rembrandt's birth date.
- 1770 Many Dutch ships are sent out on explorations, some do not return.
- 1776 Australian Colonisation.
- 1880 Ned Kelly hanged in Melbourne November 11.
- 1938 Queen Beatrix born.
- 1939-45 The Netherlands and Australia are allies in World War II.
- 1953 The Flood of Zeeland.
- 1988 Australia's Bicentenary.
- 2000 Australia hosts the Olympics in which Pieter van den Hoogenband competed.
- 2005 The first House of Tomorrow built in the Netherlands.
- 2006 Australia and the Netherlands celebrate 400 years of friendship.
