



ANZAC Centenary and ANZAC Day

Make a Poppy

Use the template to create and decorate a poppy for ANZAC Day.

What you will need:

- Scissors
- Glue
- Red pencils/textas

Optional

- Red crepe paper
- Pipe cleaner (*preferably green*)
- Safety pin
- Sticky tape

Instructions:

1. Colour the poppy red.
Alternatively you can cut out the poppy shape and trace it on to some red crepe paper.
2. Cut out the poppy.
3. Cut out the black circle.
4. Stick the black circle in the middle of the poppy
5. If you would like to wear the poppy, tape a safety pin to the back of it.
Alternatively, you can attach a pipe cleaner to the poppy (*by poking a hole in the middle of the poppy and threading the pipe cleaner through*) then plant the class' poppies in a tray of soil to create a poppy field.
