Christmas Piñata


To make your own piñata decoration, follow these instructions.


What you will need:

- Piñata template (this can be enlarged to A3 if you wish)
- scissors
- coloured pencils or Textas
- sticky tape
- tissue paper or scrunched up paper (to fill the piñata)
- glue
- crepe paper, glitter or other items to decorate the piñata
- string.

Instructions

- 1. Cut out the two templates on the next page.
- 2. If you are going to colour your piñata, it is easier to do it now, before you stick the two pieces together.
- 3. Lay the two star pieces on top of each other.
- 4. Use the sticky tape to join the pieces together. Leave one or two points unstuck to allow room for stuffing.
- 5. Fill the piñata with scrunched up paper or tissue.
- 6. Stick the last points together to seal the piñata.
- Decorate the piñata with glitter or scrunched up crepe paper if you wish.
- 8. Tape a piece of string to the piñata so you can hang it.
