CHRISTMAS AROUND THE WORLD

Make a Christmas Tree

What you will need:

- A Christmas tree template
- Things to colour the tree (e.g. pencils, crayons, textas, paint etc.)
- A piece of card or cardboard (the same size as the Christmas tree template)
- Scissors
- Craft glue or a glue stick

Instructions

- 1. Colour in the two parts of the Christmas tree.
- 2. Glue the Christmas tree template on to a piece of card or cardboard.
- 3. Cut out each Christmas tree, but do not cut down the dotted line yet.
- 4. Now cut a slit in each part of the tree using the dotted line as a guide.
- 5. The thickness of the card or cardboard you have used will determine how wide the slit needs to be *(thicker card requires a wider slit)*.
- 6. Slide the two pieces of the tree together. The length of the slit may need to be adjusted to enable the tree to stand unsupported on a table.
- 7. Add some more decorations to the tree if you wish.
