CALCULATING WITH AUSTRALIAN NOTES AND COINS

Currency continuum

Follow these instructions to make a currency mobile and show your understanding of ordering the Australian notes and coins from lowest to highest value.

What you will need:

- Coin and note pictures (on pages 2 and 3)
- Scissors
- String
- Masking tape
- Coloured pencils

What to do:

- 1. Colour the coins and notes as close as possible to the correct colours.
- 2. Cut out the coin and note pictures.
- 3. Vertically, put the coins and notes in order from the lowest to highest value.
- 4. Turn the coins and notes over so the pictures are facing down. Make sure they stay in the correct order.
- 5. Lay a piece of string along the back coins and notes (see picture).
- 6. Use a piece of masking tape to stick the string to the back of each coin/note.
- 7. Display your currency mobile around the classroom.
