He arrives at each house fifteen minutes apart: at 1am, 1.15am, 1.30am, finally visiting the last house at 1.45am.


Use the clues provided to find out:

- **1.** Who lives in each house.
- 2. What colour Easter egg was delivered to each house.
- **3.** What time the Easter Bilby delivered the egg to each house (keep in mind, the houses may not have been visited in numerical order).

Clues:

- Sara lives at house number 2.
- If you combine the colours of the eggs delivered to house number 1 and house number 3 you will get the colour of the egg delivered to house number 4. (Hint: Consider which colours are secondary. Which secondary colour can be made from two of the provided colours?)
- The Easter Bilby's first delivery was to house number 3.
- The Easter Bilby's last delivery was to Tony.
- House number 3 received a blue egg.
- Tony's house number is higher than Sara's.
- Vivian received a blue egg.
- The egg delivered to house number 1 is a primary colour.
- House number 1 received its delivery 30 minutes before house number 4.
