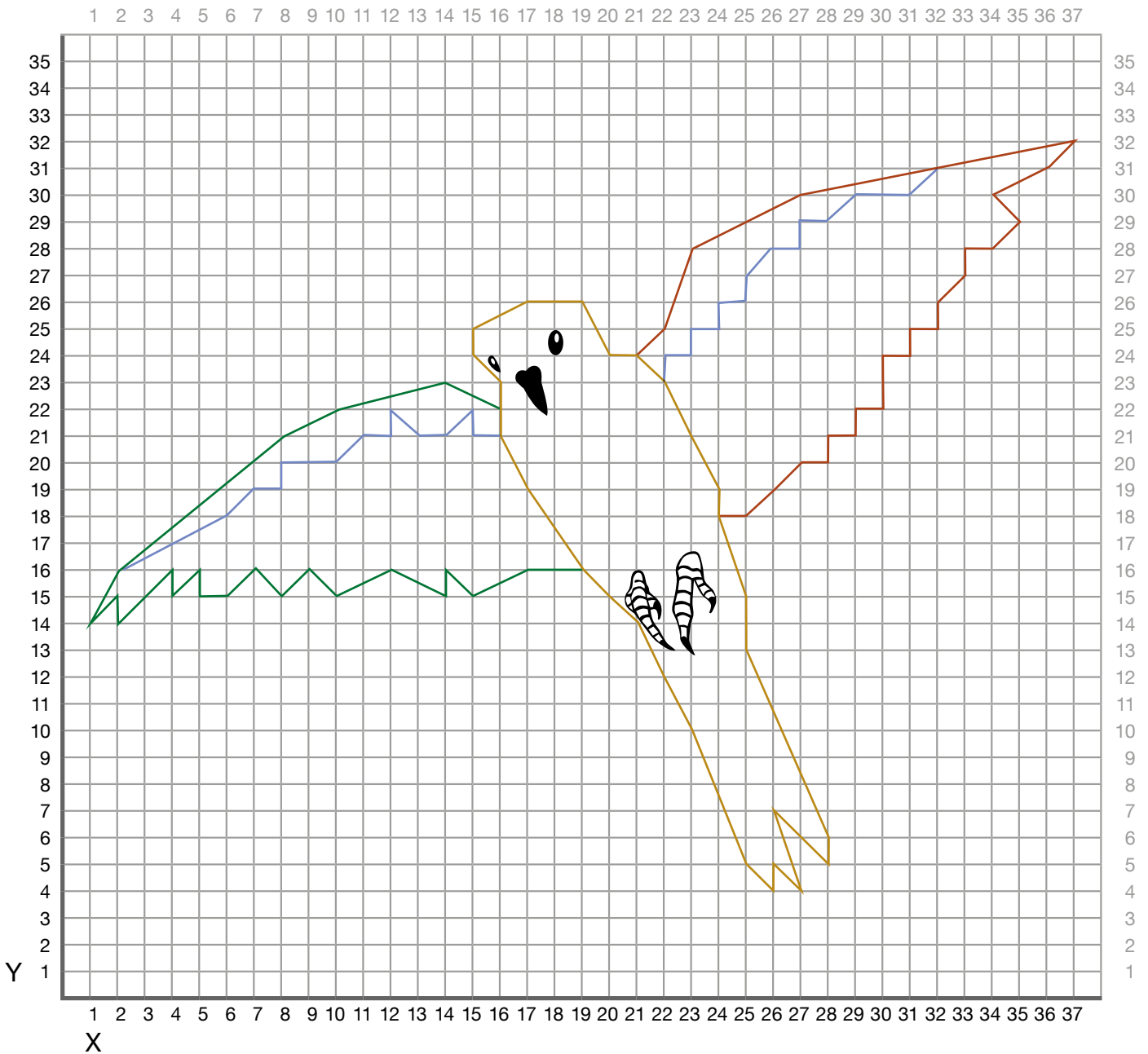

## Endangered wildlife comprehension

- It was named because its striped appearance was thought to resemble the ceremonial markings Indigenous Australians paint on their bodies in preparation for a corroboree.
- The only place the Southern Corroboree Frog can be found is in a small area of Mt Kosciuszko National Park.
- Human poachers, who hunt for them for their spotted pelts (skin/fur) and their body parts which are used in traditional medicine.
- Nine metres.
- 150 kilograms.
- Melbourne Zoo, Perth Zoo, Taronga Zoo and Taronga Western Plains Zoo at Dubbo.

- Commercial hunting and disease.
- Carnivore.
- It is threatened due to land clearing for houses and agriculture, use of pesticides and fertilisers and from bushfire. It is also a victim of feral predators such as cats, rats and foxes.
- Fewer than 50 birds.
- They have a bright grass-green plumage (feather coverage) above and light green to bright yellow below. They have a royal blue patch on the outer wing, a bright orange patch on the lower belly and a blue bar across their forehead above the nostrils.

- The Northern Quoll eats several species of native frogs and also introduced Cane Toads. Cane Toads are poisonous and kill any quoll that eats them.
