



MOTHER'S DAY

Hand-Print Tulip Card

What you will need:

- A4 sheets of cardboard or paper
- Paint (various colours)
- Paintbrushes
- Green pipe cleaners
- Leaves (collected from the ground, not taken from trees)
- Glue

Instructions

1. Fold a piece of cardboard in half to make a greeting card.
2. Glue a green pipe cleaner to the front of the card to make the stem of the tulip. Be sure to leave enough space for your hand-print to fit above the stem.
3. Glue a leaf on each side of the stem.
4. Choose the colour for your tulip and paint one of your palms that colour.
5. Press your palm down on to the card so your hand-print makes the flower part of the tulip.
6. Put aside to let the paint and glue dry.
