## Hand-Print Tulip Card

What you will need:

- A4 sheets of cardboard or paper
- Paint (various colours)
- Paintbrushes
- Green pipe cleaners
- Leaves (collected from the ground, not taken from trees)
- Glue

## Instructions

- 1. Fold a piece of cardboard in half to make a greeting card.
- 2. Glue a green pipe cleaner to the front of the card to make the stem of the tulip. Be sure to leave enough space for your hand-print to fit above the stem.
- 3. Glue a leaf on each side of the stem.
- 4. Choose the colour for your tulip and paint one of your palms that colour.
- 5. Press your palm down on to the card so your hand-print makes the flower part of the tulip.
- 6. Put aside to let the paint and glue dry.
