MOTHER'S DAY

Quilling card

What you will need:

- Several A4 sheets of coloured cardboard or paper in various colours. Light (or pastel) complementary colours work best.
- Paintbrush with a thin handle (to coil paper around)
- Sticky tape
- Glue (white glue or glue sticks)
- Scissors

Instructions

- Choose a colour for your Mother's Day card. Fold the 1. selected A4 sheet in half to make a greeting card. Glue a smaller piece of white paper to the inside of the card to write your greeting.
- 2. Cut two strips of card (both the same colour) measuring 1 cm wide and 20 cm long.

Use these strips to make a heart shape on the front of the card. Secure the two meeting points with tape. Use some small pieces of tape around the heart secure it to the card.

- Choose three colours to make coils. Cut 1 cm wide 3. strips of each colour. Wrap the strips around the thin paintbrush handle to make small, tight coils.
- 4. Coat one side of a coil with white glue or a glue stick and place it in the heart, starting in the top left.
- 5. Repeat with the remaining coils, mixing up the colours, until your heart shape is full of coils. Put aside to let the glue dry.
- Write your greeting. 6.

Your card is now finished.
