- 11. Australia and the Olympic and Paralympic Games Facts sentences:
  - Amazingly, more than <u>3000</u> Australians have competed at a Summer Olympic Games since <u>Athens</u> in 1896.
  - Australia has sent competitors to every Paralympic Games since they began in Rome in 1960 and has won a total of 1205 medals.
  - Since the 1896 Olympic Games in Athens and up to the 2024 Games in Paris, Australia has won a total of **554** Summer Olympic medals.
  - There are many similarities between the Paralympic and Olympic Games: both have **opening** and **closing** ceremonies, both are preceded by a torch **relay**, and both include **competitors** from all over the world.
  - Would you believe that the first recorded Olympic Games only had <u>one</u> event? It was a running race called the '<u>Stade</u>', which was 192m long.
  - Sydney 2000 was the most <u>successful</u> Olympic Games for Australia to date, with Australia winning a total of 58 medals including 16 gold.
