REMEMBRANCE DAY

Poppy poster

What you will need:


- A4 sheet of white card or paper (or use the template on page 2)
- Red crepe paper or serviette
- Small piece of black card
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Coloured pencils or textas

Instructions

- 1. Tear the crepe paper into small pieces (approximately 1 cm).
- 2. On the white card or paper, draw two poppy flower outlines or use the template provided.
- 3. Apply glue to the inside of the flower shapes and begin placing torn red paper into the shapes, taking care to stay as close to the lines as possible.
- 4. Continue applying paper until both the flowers are covered.
- 5. Cut two small circles from the black card (about the size of a 10 cent piece) and glue one in the centre of each flower.
- 6. Use a coloured pencil or texta to add a stem to each flower.

Your poster is finished.












