Crazy chronology – South Australia

Date	Fact
1836	Ships carrying 200 free settlers arrive in South Australia
8 April 1802	Two explorers, Baudin and Flinders, unexpectedly met near Victor Harbor.
1904	The South Australian flag is introduced.
1961	The Sturt Desert Pea becomes the floral emblem of South Australia.
1985	The opal becomes the gemstone emblem of South Australia.
1929	The first train runs along the original Ghan railway line. It was steam powered.
End of December 2012	The South Australian population reaches 1,662,200.
