Common clouds

Here is some information about three types of clouds.



Cirrus

I am a cirrus cloud.

I stay up high in the sky.

I am thin and wispy and look like tufts of hair.

I am made of ice particles.

During the day I will be very white, but at sunrise or sunset I can take on the colours of the rising or falling sun.




I am a cumulus cloud.

I am a low to mid-level cloud (I don't go up high).

I am big, white, fluffy and round. I often have a flat bottom and look like cotton wool on top.

You will see me on days with good weather.

Stratus

I am a stratus cloud.

I stay low in the sky.

I am grey, flat and can cover a lot of the sky. I look like a grey blanket.

If I go low enough I can become fog.

I produce light rain or drizzle.
