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### Seasons wheel - blank

Follow these instructions to make a seasons wheel.


#### What you will need:

- Seasons wheel template (on pages 2 and 3)
- Scissors
- Coloured pencils
- A split pin

#### What to do:

- 1. Cut out both of the circles.
- 2. On one template you will need to cut out a triangle shape as shown.
- 3. Write a season name in each quarter of the template and draw a picture that matches the season.
- 4. Write the months that go with this season in the space on the edge.
- 5. Poke a hole through both pieces (where the black dot is). You might need an adult to help you with this.
- Push the split pin through both pieces of the template to hold them together.
- 7. Open out the 'legs' of the split pin.

Now your seasons wheel should spin to show you the season and the months.










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
