Fascinating dragonflies

- 1. 300 million years
- **2.** 6,000
- 3. Five giant species of dragonfly
- 4. Collected a dragonfly specimen at Endeavour River in 1775
- 5. Carboniferous period
- 6. Well-developed eyes and capacity for flight
- 7. Large, yet delicate
- 8. Prosimii and Anthropoidea
- 'Like other insects, dragonflies have a head, thorax, abdomen and six legs.'
- 10. Options include:
 - Dragonflies are usually larger and more powerful than damselflies.
 - Damselflies are lighter and smaller than dragonflies and their flight is weaker and flutterier.
 - Dragonflies have broader hindwings than forewings, while damselfly wings are evenly sized.
 - Dragonflies rest with their wings outstretched, but damselflies fold them close to their abdomen.
 - Dragonfly larvae have their gills on the inside (internal), whereas on a damselfly they are on the outside (external).
- **11.** The ability to move its wings independently
- 12. Up to 70 kilometres per hour
- 13. Egg, larva, adult
- 14. Larva (or nymph)
- 15. They do not have a pupal stage
