Display Pod

Would you like an interesting way to display information or images?

Follow the instructions below to make your very own display pod .

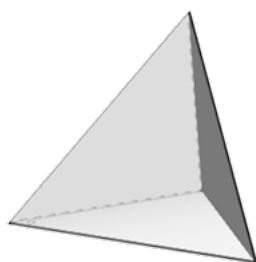
Note: You can enlarge the template to A3 if you want a bigger pod.

What you will need

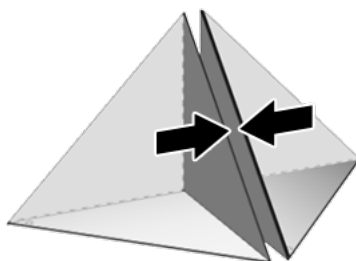
- Template on page 2 (up to four of these)
- Scissors
- Glue.

Instructions

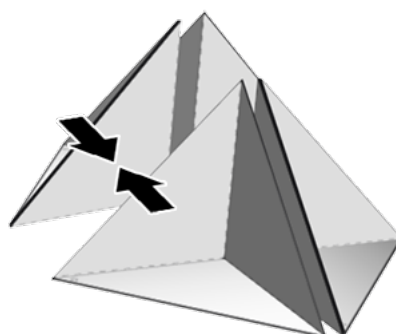
1. Cut out the square template (on page 2) and fold the top left corner to the opposite bottom corner. Make a crease along the dotted line.
2. Unfold and repeat with the top right corner folding it to the bottom left corner.
3. Unfold and carefully cut along the solid black line, stopping at the middle.
4. Add information, decoration or illustrations to each panel. (You can do this after folding, but it is much easier to do it now.)
5. Spread glue onto the shaded triangle labelled 'glue'.
6. Complete your pod by matching the two circles and pressing together to form the base. Make sure the shaded 'glue' panel is covered by another panel.
7. You can make up to 4 of these 'pods' and glue or tape them together to make an interesting display piece.
