NARRATIVE

The purpose of a narrative is to **ENTERTAIN**

STRUCTURE:

- **ORIENTATION**
Think who, where and when.
- **COMPLICATION**
A problem arises in the story.
- **RESOLUTION**
The problem is resolved.
- **CODA (maybe)**
A moral message or comment about the characters.

LANGUAGE FEATURES

- **SPECIFIC PARTICIPANTS**
People (or sometimes animals) with defined identities.
- **A VARIETY OF VERBS**
Verbs show us what the characters are saying, doing, thinking or feeling.
- **DESCRIPTIVE WORDS OR PHRASES**
These help the audience to create a picture in their mind and make the story interesting.
- **DIALOGUE AND THOUGHTS**
This tells us what the characters are saying or thinking.
- **CONJUNCTIONS AND CONNECTIVES**
(e.g. then, next, after, because, meanwhile, but)
These keep the story flowing and help it make sense.
