RECOUNT

The purpose of a recount is to RETELL something that happened.

STRUCTURE:

- ORIENTATION A brief introduction that explains who, what, where and when.
- SERIES OF EVENTS These should be in the order they happened.
- FINAL COMMENT / CONCLUSION This could be a personal comment or opinion.

LANGUAGE FEATURES

PAST TENSE

As the events happened in the past, we use past tense words.

SPECIFIC PARTICIPANTS

Recounts often refer to specific people, places or events, so make sure you use proper nouns (remember they have a capital letter).

TIME CONNECTIVES (e.g. first, then, after, finally, next, during) This helps the recount flow and make sense. The audience will know the order the events happened.
