#### Prime and composite numbers

a) A prime number can only be divided by itself and 1. Prime numbers between 0 and 20 are:

2, 3, 5, 7, 11, 13, 17, 19

b) A composite number can be divided by numbers other than 1 and itself. Composite numbers between 0 and 20 are:

4, 6, 8, 9, 10, 12, 14, 15, 16, 18, 20

#### Measurement and Units

'mm' is short for millimetre	20mm = 2cm
'cm' is short for centimetre	4 000mm = 4m
'm' is short for metre	300cm = 3m
'km' is short for kilometre	5 000m = 5km
'mg' is short for milligram	1 000mg = 1g
'g' is short for gram	6 000g = 6kg
'kg' is short for kilogram	1 500g = 1.5kg
't' is short for tonne	8 000kg = 8t

#### How many days in each month of the year?

**Thirty** days has September, April, **June** and **November**.

All the rest have thirty-**one**, except for **February**, which has twenty-**eight** days clear and twenty-nine in each **leap** year.
