
TEMPLATES

Cow model instructions

You will need:

- Cow template pieces, enlarged to A3
- Scissors
- Sticky tape
- Glue stick
- Ruler

Instructions:



- Starting with the body, cut around the outside of the shape, following the solid line, and then use a ruler to make a sharp fold along each of the dotted lines. (Make sure you fold in towards the back of the template.)
- 2. Fold the body into a cube shape and secure the sides with sticky tape.
- 3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 with the 4 leg pieces to create small rectangular prisms (cuboids).
- 4. Apply glue to the top of each leg and attach them to the bottom of the body using the hexagon shapes as a guide.

Hint: Place some coins on top to hold everything down while the glue dries.

- 5. Cut around both of the horn shapes and fold back the sections marked with an x then attach them to the side of the head with glue. Make sure the x marks line up.
- 6. Repeat step 5 with the ears, matching the grey dots to position them on to the head.
- 7. Cut out the udder shape and glue it to the back of the rear legs.
- 8. (Optional) Make a base by cutting a square out of a piece of cardboard and gluing it to the bottom of the cow's feet.
