



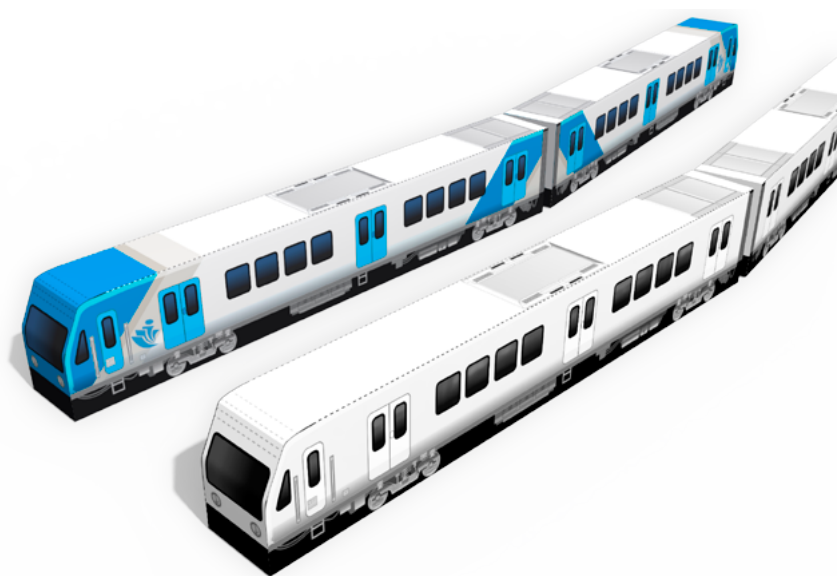
TEMPLATES

Train paper model

Follow the instructions below to make your own train paper model.

What you will need:

- Templates (there are black and white or coloured versions on pages 2 and 3). Please note: the trains will be easier to make and more stable if the templates are printed onto thin card or stuck to cardboard (e.g. from a cereal box).
- Scissors
- Glue stick or sticky tape
- Ruler
- Coloured pencils (if using the black and white template)



Instructions:

1. Colour the train (if you are using the black and white template).
2. Carefully cut out each of the template pieces, following the solid black line (the dotted lines are for folding).
3. Use a ruler to fold along each dotted line. The ruler helps you get a strong, sharp fold. Fold the piece so it forms a neat rectangular prism.
4. Apply glue to the tabs and carefully press each of them to secure the folds in place. Put aside to dry.

This step can also be done with sticky tape.

5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 with the second body shape to create another carriage.
6. Fold the small strip into a concertina and use it to connect the ends of both carriages together (see illustration).
