
Make a Triceratops


What you will need:

- Template (on page 2)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Coloured pencils (optional)

Instructions:

- 1. Colour in your dinosaur (if you would like to).
- 2. Cut out the body and head template. Follow the solid line and be careful not to cut off the little tabs that connect the body together.
- 3. Fold the body in half along the dotted line.
- 4. Glue the ends of the tabs with one dot together and stick the body together. After you have done this, your triceratops should be able to stand up.
- 5. Put some glue at the top of the head and stick that together too.
- 6. Cut out the neck frill template.
- 7. Fold both lower sides of the neck frill under, along the dotted lines.
- 8. Put some glue on the folded pieces and position them on the back of the Triceratops' neck as shown and pinch in place until dry.
- 9. Cut out the two horn and single nose horn templates.
- 10. Fold the nose horn in half and glue to the inside of the nose as shown.
- 11. Fold back the tabs on each remaining horn and glue one to each side of the frill.
