



TEMPLATES

Make a Triceratops

What you will need:

- Template (on page 2)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Coloured pencils (optional)

Instructions:

1. Colour in your dinosaur (if you would like to).
2. Cut out the body and head template. Follow the solid line and be careful not to cut off the little tabs that connect the body together.
3. Fold the body in half along the dotted line.
4. Glue the ends of the tabs with one dot together and stick the body together. After you have done this, your triceratops should be able to stand up.
5. Put some glue at the top of the head and stick that together too.
6. Cut out the neck frill template.
7. Fold both lower sides of the neck frill under, along the dotted lines.
8. Put some glue on the folded pieces and position them on the back of the Triceratops' neck as shown and pinch in place until dry.
9. Cut out the two horn and single nose horn templates.
10. Fold the nose horn in half and glue to the inside of the nose as shown.
11. Fold back the tabs on each remaining horn and glue one to each side of the frill.
