Make a Christmas tree bookmark


Follow these instructions to make a Christmas tree bookmark.

What you will need:

- green origami paper (127mm x 127mm works best)
- brown paper (to cut a trunk)
- scissors
- tape or glue
- decorations (e.g. glitter, sequins, stickers, pom poms etc.)

What to do:

- 1. Fold the paper in half, diagonally to make a crease. Do this both ways.
- 2. Fold into a triangle with the coloured side facing out (if your paper is only coloured on one side).
- 3. Fold from the tip of the triangle to the bottom (one sheet only).



- 4. Fold the right corner of the triangle to the centre. Repeat with the left corner. Crease well and unfold.
- 5. Fold the right corner up to the top of the triangle and crease well. Tuck the 'flap' into the 'pocket' as shown. Repeat with the other side.
- 6. Cut the Christmas tree shape as shown. Be careful to only cut triangles so the bookmark keeps its shape.
- 7. Cut a rectangle shape from brown paper and tape or glue it to the bottom of the tree (on the inside of the pocket) to make a trunk.
- 8. Decorate your tree however you wish.

Now your bookmark is ready to use in your favourite book or give as a Christmas gift.
