Make a Christmas tree bookmark

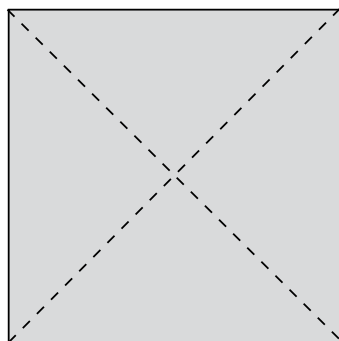
Follow these instructions to make a Christmas tree bookmark.

What you will need:

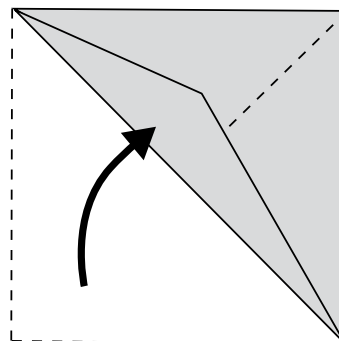
- green origami paper (127mm x 127mm works best)
- brown paper (to cut a trunk)
- scissors
- tape or glue
- decorations (e.g. glitter, sequins, stickers, pom poms etc.)

What to do:

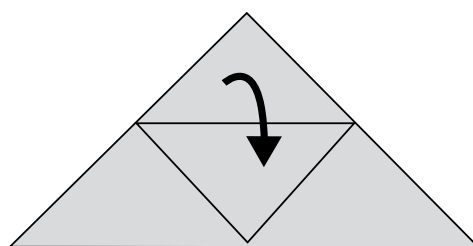
1. Fold the paper in half, diagonally to make a crease. Do this both ways.
2. Fold into a triangle with the coloured side facing out (if your paper is only coloured on one side).
3. Fold from the tip of the triangle to the bottom (one sheet only).

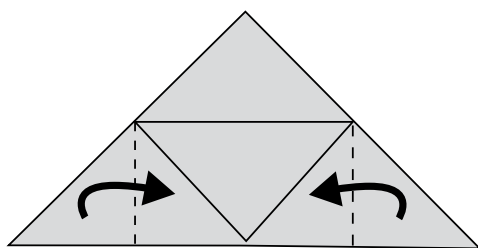

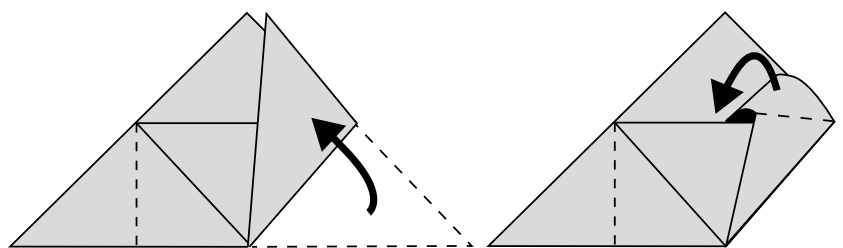

4. Fold the right corner of the triangle to the centre. Repeat with the left corner. Crease well and unfold.
5. Fold the right corner up to the top of the triangle and crease well. Tuck the 'flap' into the 'pocket' as shown. Repeat with the other side.
6. Cut the Christmas tree shape as shown. Be careful to only cut triangles so the bookmark keeps its shape.
7. Cut a rectangle shape from brown paper and tape or glue it to the bottom of the tree (on the inside of the pocket) to make a trunk.
8. Decorate your tree however you wish.

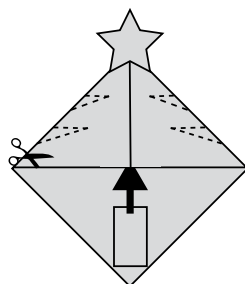
Now your bookmark is ready to use in your favourite book or give as a Christmas gift.



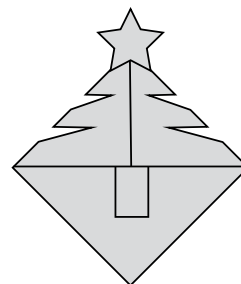

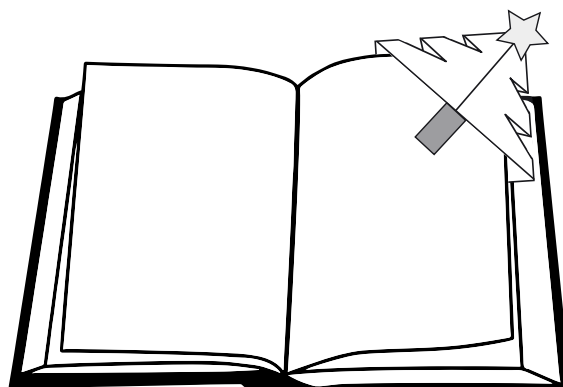
